JESUS AND THE PEOPLE HE MET...



Discussion Questions after Jesus & Kids Video


This video tells the story of Timmy, a little boy who was so excited to meet Jesus. Until, some of Jesus' disciples try to stop him...

- 1. Why do you think Timmy was so excited to meet Jesus?
- 2. Why did the disciples try to stop Timmy and the other kids coming to Jesus?
- 3. What did Jesus say to the disciples? What did he say to the kids? What does this tell us about how Jesus feels about kids?

Pray

Thank Jesus that he wants kids to come to him, trust him and be part of his Kingdom forever.

Ask God to help you tell your friends that Jesus wants them to come to him and be part of his Kingdom forever.

How to use 'Digging Deeper' for the 'Jesus and' series.

To help you through our 'Jesus and..' series, each week we will provide three devotions. We encourage you to read these passages with those in your household at a time that suits, and use the questions to guide you as you talk about and reflect on how Jesus related to the people he met and how we are to relate to Jesus.

We looked at several different Bible translations when creating these questions. Feel free to use any version as you work through them with your family.

Memory Verse Challenge

Jesus said: "Let the little children come to me!" Join in with the Quiz Worx humans and puppets as they sing and dance to Jesus' words in the Book of Mark, and be reminded that Jesus LOVES kids and wants kids to be part of God's Kingdom forever. Something to Remember

As we look at how Jesus related to the people he met in the gospels, we will see that Jesus wants all people to know him, trust him and be part of God's Kingdom forever.

As you look at each passage, keep asking:

- a) What do we learn about who Jesus is and what he is like?
- b) What do we learn about how people are to relate to Jesus?
- c) Who can I tell about Jesus?

Devotion 1 - Matthew 18: 1-5

The disciples wanted to know "Who, then, is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" Jesus' answer surprises them all!

- 1. Why do you think the disciples wanted to know who was the greatest?
- 2. What does Jesus say people must do to enter the kingdom of heaven? What do you think Jesus meant by this?
- 3. What might it look like for you to humble yourself the way Jesus describes?

Pray

Thank God that people just need to trust Jesus to be a part of God's kingdom.

Ask God to help you to be humble and to love and serve other people by sharing the Good News of Jesus with them. (One way to do this would be to invite your friends to watch QWHD with you).

Family Devotions

Devotion 2 - Mark 10: 13-16

The disciples thought that Jesus was too important for children, but Jesus shows them that kids can be part of God's kingdom too.

- 1. How were the disciples treating the children?
- 2. How did Jesus treat the children?
- 3. How does it make you feel that Jesus wants kids to come to him and be part of his Kingdom forever? Have you come to Jesus and put your trust in him?

Pray

Thank Jesus that children can be part of God's kingdom too!

Pray that more people will come to Jesus, trusting him as their King.

Devotion 3 - John 6: 1-15

In this passage thousands of people come to hear Jesus speak about God and His Kingdom, but how were they all going to eat? Let's find out...

- 1. How much food did the boy have?
- 2. What do you think the boy who shared his lunch learnt about Jesus that day?
- 3. How does it make you feel that Jesus is so powerful and that he cares for people?
- **4.** Is Jesus worth trusting? Why?

Pray

Take some time to thank God for all the good things he has given you.

Pray that you will always remember how powerful and caring Jesus is and that he gives us everything we need.
